

The Cyprus Peace and Dialogue Centre (CPDC)

in partnership with the **Interdisciplinary centre for Law, Alternative and Innovative Methods (ICLAIM)** is launching a 2-year EU funded project titled '*EMBRACE: Rights for Reconciliation*'.

The project will see the establishment of a bi-communal reporting mechanism on discriminatory inter-communal human rights violations under the guidance of a research consortium, with published findings and policy recommendations forming advocacy strategies at local and international levels. Beyond targeted legal aid for victims, the project will be comprised of: anti-racism training for civil servants at relevant services across the divide; a best-practice sharing session with other human rights NGOs in Cyprus; and public findings dissemination sessions with built-in confidence building workshops.
